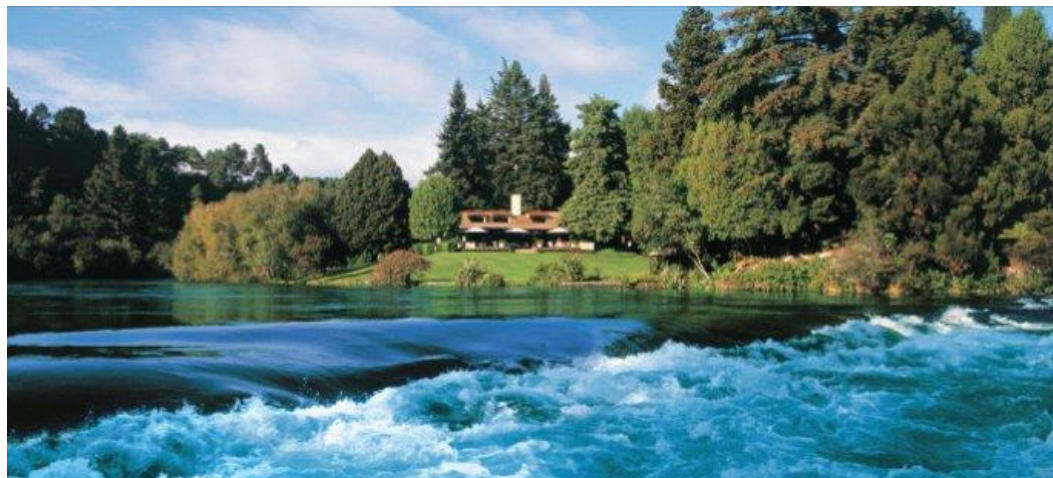
AUCKLAND TAUPO

Farewell the "City of Sails" and travel south to Hamilton - New Zealand's fourth largest city. The journey continues through the fertile Waikato region, and the exotic pine forests to the popular resort township of Lake Taupo. The area owes its landscapes to its dramatic volcanic origins. Lake Taupo is home to New Zealand's largest lake and the spectacular Huka Falls. A nearby loop road leads to the spectacular Huka Falls. Here the full force of the newly born Waikato River hurtles from the narrow gorge over a 12 metre ledge. Lit by bridge sunshine, the ice cold water takes on a turquoise-blue colour as it hangs in mid air before crashing into a foaming basin - "Huka" meaning foam.

Taupo is one of the main centres on the volcanic plateau located on the edge of New Zealand's largest lake, famous for trout fishing. With natural hot springs, and a picturesque outlook to the snow-capped mountains of Tongariro National Park to the south, it's no surprise that Taupo is a favourite playground for outdoor enthusiasts and those that just want to relax and unwind.

Enjoy pre-dinner drinks, and 5 courses dinner (menu changes daily) at your lodge tonight.

&

Both today and tomorrow are at your leisure to relax or explore what Taupo has to offer.

The beautiful **Lake Taupo** is about the size of Singapore – more of an inland sea really.

It was created nearly two thousand years ago by a volcanic eruption so big it darkened the skies in Europe and China. Visit the Craters of the Moon (optional) and you'll see evidence of the lake's fiery birth in the geysers, steaming craters and boiling mud pools. At some of Lake Taupo's beaches, swimmers and paddlers can enjoy warm, geothermal water currents.

Just north of Lake Taupo you'll find New Zealand's most visited attraction, the magnificent Huka Falls, where more than 220,000 litres of water thunder over the cliff face every second.

Taupo is a great lake for water-skiing, sailing and kayaking. The Maori rock carvings at Mine Bay, which can only be seen from the water, make for a great boat trip or kayaking excursion. The forests surrounding the lake offer hiking and mountain biking to suit all levels of experience.





Day 6

TAUPO ROTORUA BLENHEIM MARLBOROUGH SOUNDS

Depart Taupo, continue north via the Wairakei Geothermal area and through the Kaingaroa forest, one of the largest man made forests in the world. Take in the spectacular views of Rainbow Mountain, on this short journey to Rotorua.

From the moment you arrive in Rotorua you know you're somewhere quite different. There is a scent of sulphur in the air, and at nearby geothermal hotspots there are spouting geysers, mud pools bubbling and belching, and warm geothermal pools and ponds that create a kaleidoscope of colour. Rotorua is also the heartland of New Zealand's Maori culture, and visitors can enjoy a performance of song and dance, followed by food cooked in a traditional hangi (cooked in an earthen oven).

PICTON KAIKOURA

Depart Picton via Blenheim and travel south across the Awatere River, with its farms and vineyards flanked by rugged mountains. Rural townships along the route include Seddon and Ward, both great places to seek out authentic local crafts. Maybe stop for a coffee on the beach at Kekerengu to visit the seals at Ohau Point. This journey is a scenic feast of New Zealand, with the Kaikoura mountain ranges on one side and the rugged Pacific Ocean coastline on the other. It is a short time before arriving in the village of Kaikoura, a town steeped in Maori history and legend and famous for its whales.

Kaikoura, a unique combination of ocean and mountains, is famous for its amazing eco-tourism, including Whale Watching and Dolphin swimming anytime of the year! Kaikoura often hosts the world's largest dolphin - the Orca - and is home to the world's smallest and rarest - the Hector. Kaikoura also attracts the largest concentration and variety of seabirds on mainland New Zealand including 13 species of Albatross, 14 varieties of Petrels and 7 types of Shearwater. The name Kaikoura literally means food - kai, and crayfish - koura, an industry that continues to thrive in the region thanks to this natural phenomenon.

Day 10

KAIKOURA CHRISTCHURCH MT COOK **KAIKOURA CHRISTCHURCH**

Leave Kaikoura behind turning inland and travel south through the rolling hill country of North Canterbury. This region encompasses rugged coastal ranges, thundering seas, fascinating cliff formations, rolling farmland and extensive vineyards and olive groves. Enjoy the beauty of its rural pastoral scenes, before reaching the ' Garden City' of Christchurch.

CHRISTCHURCH MT COOK

Leave the tranquillity of the Canterbury Plains behind, and enjoy the scenic route past small, pretty towns, travelling over the braided Rakaia River into the

MacKenzie Country. At Lake Tekapo visit the Church of the Good Shepherd. From Pukaki, the road inland to Mount Cook is a pretty drive along the edge of Lake Pukaki, a stunning glacial-fed lake. Mount Cook National Park or as known in Maori, "Aorangi", the cloud piercer, looms in the foreground.





Mount Cook Village is at the base of New Zealand's highest mountain of an impressive 3754m. Aoraki / Mount Cook National Park was awarded 'World Heritage' status in recognition of its qualities and rare beauty. The Park covers an area of nearly 7,000 hectares of majestic alpine scenery with more than one third being in permanent snow and glacial ice. The park contains 22 of the 27 peaks over 10,000 feet (3,000 metres) in New Zealand.

Day 11 MT COOK QUEENSTOWN

Depart Mount Cook and follow the shores of Lake Pukaki to the small town of Twizel. The route turns south through the MacKenzie basin and the junction town of Omarama. Then it's over the Lindis Pass to the old gold workings near Tarras and the township of Cromwell.

The narrow and rocky Kawarau Gorge leads you through this historic Central Otago region to Lake Wakatipu and the "Alpine Resort" of Queenstown.

Queenstown, nestled among glacier rounded hills and dramatic rugged mountain peaks, is one of New Zealand's major resort centres. It offers a host of holiday attractions for the visitor from helicopter flights and trips on jetboats, to walks and tramps. The township is steeped in the history of the goldmining days as is evident from the many relics scattered in and among the surrounding hills.

QUEENSTOWN MILFORD SOUND

Depart Queenstown, following the southern arm of Lake Wakatipu. Pass the Remarkables Skifield and Kingston at the southern end of the lake towards Five Rivers and Lumsden, before joining SH94 at Mossburn and onward to Lake Te Anau.

Lake Te Anau, the largest of the South Island lakes, covers 344 sq. km. It has four arms reaching to the west, separated by forested mountain ranges. Te Anau is also the natural gateway to Fiordland Park, and is the base for trips to Manapouri, the Eglinton and Hollyford Valley.

The scenery changes dramatically from tussock covered grasslands to glacier hewn valleys as you enter the Eglinton Valley. The Mirror Lakes, Cascade Creek and other many vantage points en route provide a photographer's paradise. Travel through the man made Homer Tunnel to the breath taking views of Milford Sound.

Within the World Heritage listed Fiordland National Park, this famous fiord is dominated by Mitre Peak and the cascading Bowen Falls
