Itinerary:

Day 1

Arrival Istanbul, met by our representative Transfer to the hotel assistance during the check in and information about the program in Istanbul

Day 2

Pick up at 09:30 for full day Istanbul's sightseeing program, will keep it basic but the one which is the mush once you are in Istanbul

On this tour you will drive across the magnificent Bosphorus Suspension Bridge, which divides the continents of Europe and Asia. Then, we continue to Camlica Hill, the highest point of Istanbul. From here you can take photos of the stunning panorama before you. A short drive from here is the summer palace of the Sultans which is located in a small village by the Bosphorus called Beylerbeyi.

Beylerbeyi Palace is a mansion built under the influence of Western architecture in the 19th century and we will take a guided tour of its extravagantly decorated interior. During the day you will also visit the Egyptian Spice Bazaar which is full of the mystical aromas of various spices and colorful shops selling fruit, vegetables, flowers and fish etc.





In afternoon visit Istanbul City...**HIPPODROME**, The scene of ancient chariot races, the ancient Hippodrome, with its four monuments; the **GERMAN FOUNTAIN OF WILHELM II**, the **OBELISK OF THEodosius**, the bronze **SERPENTINE COLUMN** and the **COLUMN OF CONSTANTINE**.**SULTANAHMET IMPERIAL MOSQUE** Across from **St. Sophia** built in the 17th century by the architect Mehmet, this is known as the **BLUE MOSQUE** because of its magnificent interior decoration of blue Iznik tiles. **TOPKAPI PALACE** The great palace of the **Ottoman** sultans from the 15th to the 19th centuries, housing an exquisite collection of precious gems, jewellery thrones of sultans, robes worn by the sultans and their families; miniatures, the **Holy Mantle**; **CHABER OF SACRED RELICS**.

Day 3



Pick up at 09:30 for full day Istanbul's sightseeing program

St. SOPHIA This ancient basilica, built by Constantine the Great, in the 4th century and reconstructed by Justinian in the 6th century, is one of the architectural marvels of all time.

GRAND BAZAAR(COVERED MARKET) In this labyrinth of streets and passages are more than 4000 shops with each trade having its own area; the goldsmiths' street, the carpet sellers, Turkish

arts and crafts, such as handpainted ceramic plates, hand-honed copperware, brasware and trays, water ewers, onyxware and meerschaum pipers.

Day 4

Pick up from the hotel for the departure transfer to the airport to catch up the flight to Kayseri ; On arrival Kayseri met by our representative Transfer to the hotel assistance during the check in and information about the program in Cappadocia

Day 5

OPTIONAL HOT AIR BALOON @ 120 Euro Per Person ;

Full day PVT tour of Cappadocia

Our first real encounter with Cappadocia almost Martian landscape is in the **Dervent valley**. We visit **Pasabag's "fairy chimneys"**, where the voice of the wind harmonizes with songs of the fairies. From here we pause at **Avanos** center of terracotta art which is a popular destination because of its attractive old town with cobbled streets, and views over the river and is its production of earthenware pottery, it is also the most economic activity in the town. The ceramic trade in this district and its countless pottery factories date right back to the Hittites, and the ceramic clay from the red silt of the **Kizilirmak** has always been used. A visit to ceramic & tile center to see how the ceramics made by hand. After lunch we visit the famous **Goreme Open Air Museum** to see



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the best examples of Byzantine art in Cappadocia. People of Goreme, at the heart of the Cappadocia Region, realized that these soft rocks could be easily carved out to form houses, churches, monasteries. These Christian sanctuaries contain many examples of Byzantine art from the post-iconoclastic period. These frescoes are a unique artistic achievement from this period. You visit a carpet cooperative, where you'll see how exquisite Turkish carpets are hand-woven.

SPECIAL NOTES

Guests must be able to walk approximately 1, 5 miles over uneven and cobblestone surfaces. Comfortable shoes, a hat and plenty of sunscreen are recommended as shade is limited the order of the tour itinerary may vary in order to avoid congestion. Guests should watch their step at all times in order to avoid injuries.

Day 6

Pick up from the hotel for the departure transfer to the airport to catch up the flight to Bodrum On arrival Bodrum met by our representative Transfer to the hotel assistance during the check in and information about the program in Bodrum

Day 7

Pick up from the hotel by 09:00 and full day Sightseeing tour of **Pamukkale and Hierapolis**

Drive to Pamukkale that has the meaning of the Cotton Castle in English. Once known as Hierapolis, famous for healing thermal / mineral Baths and beautiful snow-white "petrified waterfalls. After lunch visit Hierapolis, including the magnificently preserved Necropolis, the main Street and Gates, the thermal Baths, the devil's hole, and Masterpiece Theater. Pamukkale terraces are made of travertine, a sedimentary rock deposited by water from the hot springs. In this area, there are 17 hot water springs in which the temperature ranges from 35 °C to 100



°C The water that emerges from the spring is transported 320 meters (1,050 ft.) to the head of the travertine terraces and deposits calcium carbonate on a section 60 to 70 meters long covering an expanse of 240 meters to 300 meters. Swimming or a therapeutic bath in a hotel pool's hot spring mineral Waters.

SPECIAL NOTES

Guests must be able to walk approximately 0, 5 miles over of travertine without shoes. A hat and plenty of sunscreen are recommended. The order of the tour itinerary may vary in order to avoid congestion. Guests should watch their step at all times in order to avoid injuries because the waterfalls can be slippery. Due to the nature of this tour, it is recommended for guests with walkers or wheelchairs till waterfalls. Bring sunscreen and a hat, as shade is limited and bring swimwear for walking in the water at Pamukkale which is the snow-white "petrified waterfalls.
